Rehearsal Suggestions

After a rousing introduction the piece moves to a quiet treatment of Angels We Have Heard On High. Care should be taken with dynamics to insure a steady build in intensity throughout the number. Balance and blend is essential for the brass chorale at measure 54 to be most effective. Encourage players to support their sounds with plenty of air, and above all, save something for the Grandioso at measure 67 ! If using the trumpet descant, encourage the performer to stand and/or move to the front of the band so as to project above the ensemble.
