NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

As in any nedley like this, it's important to make sure that the tunes are prominent, since that's what the audience is listening for. Dynamics to achieve this are carefully marked in the score and parts.

Keep the tonguing lightly throughout, especially in the low winds, and keep percussion always dynamically under the wind textures.
